Reminder –

Liquor License & Club Rules - Historically we have a clean record with the licensing authorities and must avoid even the slightness possibility of any breach going forward. To this end, be sure you read and abide by the Club Rules posted in the club room and attached to this email.

Guest Register – Reminder that all member's guests <u>must</u> be registered on the Guest Form available in the club room.

Club Day Drinks — A reminder that drinks are free on club day however our licensing rules stipulate alcoholic drinks cannot be taken outside our defined red line area. This means you are welcome to grab a beer from the fridge, but you must consume it within our licensed area. (Check the Red Line Area map displayed in the club room so you are aware of our licensed area).



Course Update/Preferred Lies -

It's muddy if you haven't noticed, and preferred lies will be in force for a while. As always, check the notice board for the daily updates before you tee-off.
